Human rights and environmental issues are a priority for Bunge and we take seriously any allegations and concerns raised on these key areas.

We continuously implement our corporate policies and strong governance within our operations and our supply chains – including monitoring and checking competent authorities' developments.

Deforestation remains a critical concern for Bunge, and we continue our work to address deforestation risks through actions including advancing sustainable agriculture practices, promoting the use of internationally recognized certifications, and disincentivizing native vegetation conversion, among others. We encourage you to read our 2024 Bunge Corporate Sustainability Report for more detail on our important efforts and progress.

Bunge is committed to respecting and promoting universally accepted standards of human rights within our operations and across our supply chains and we are advancing in our governance, including a formal grievance procedure (<https://investors.bunge.com/resource/report-a-concern>) and we encourage you to follow it.
